1. The event will be held under the provisions of the National Sporting Code of the current Manual (including amendments) produced by Motorsport New Zealand and any relevant regulations, prescriptions or specifications relating thereto, HBCC Autocross Rules (2004) and these Supplementary Regulations.

3. Minimum license requirement for this event is Club Membership of a Motorsport New Zealand affiliated Club.
4. All entries must be on an official HBCC entry form. Entries will be accepted on the day at the venue until **12.30pm, online entries via the MSNZ online system are the preferred method of entry.**
5. You must report to enter first. You will then be told whether or not you will need to be scrutineered. **Scrutineering is from 12.30pm to 1.00pm at the venue.**
6. Drivers briefing will be at **1.30pm**. This is compulsory for all drivers. The event starts immediately after drivers briefing.
7. No alcohol is to be consumed by competitors or crew members as this will result in immediate expulsion from the event.
8. Competition numbers supplied by HBCC will be returned in the condition they were given out in at the conclusion of the event or there will be a charge of \$10.00.
9. All competitors must start the practice run to be eligible to take part in the official runs. There will be one practice run which will take place at the beginning of the event. All competitors shall have the same number of runs. There will be three (3) official runs on the course with the aggregate time of all the runs shall constitute the final result.
10. As per the HBCC 2004 Autocross Rules. If a marker cone is knocked over a penalty of five seconds will be incurred. An obvious attempt must be made to complete the course properly. Missing out a cone or course marker will result in immediate exclusion. The Organiser will be Judge of Fact.
11. **AUTOCROSS TYRES:** Tyres will be as per HBCC 2004 Autocross Rules. Normal road or racing tyres are permitted. No rally-type pattern, studs or chains are permitted. The Organiser will be Judge of Fact.
12. Prize giving venue will be in the HBCC Clubrooms after the event.
13. The Organiser has the right to change the venue or call off the event.

Please note: Carriage of Passengers Passengers may be carried at the discretion of the Clerk of Course provided that Appendix 5, Schedule C, Part 1, Art 6 is adhered to: All vehicles carrying passengers shall be fitted with the following equipment, which must comply with Appendix 2, Schedule A: - Rollcage, - Both front seats, - four, five or six point safety harness for both occupants. Passengers shall wear safety apparel as specified in the safety schedule contained in Appendix 2, Schedule A. All passengers shall be briefed on basic event safety procedures, how to correctly wear and subsequently uncouple the safety harness and shall sign the Passenger Indemnity and Declaration Form prior to their participation. Passengers under the age of 16 are not permitted unless they hold a Motorsport NZ authorised minors licence, and between 12 and 16 years must present either a valid Junior Competition Licence or an underage indemnity form signed by a parent or guardian. Passengers may be changed between runs.
