This event will be held under the provisions of the National Sporting Code of Motorsport New Zealand and any relevant regulations prescriptions or specifications relating thereto as contained in the current NZ Motorsport Manual and amendments, HBCC Speed Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations, and Articles for the Engine Room Series.

The Permit is for a Clubsport Advanced Bent Sprint.

Licence Requirements: All drivers shall hold an M Grade or higher Motorsport NZ issued Competition Licence. If the Entrant is other than the driver, an Entrants Licence in the name of the Entrant is required. In addition, all drivers shall hold a valid civil driver's licence, and Club Membership of a Motorsport NZ affiliated Club.

All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A. Please be aware of the new requirements that came into effect on the 1st April 2018.

Passengers may be carried in vehicles complying with Appendix 5, Schedule C, Part 1, of the current MSNZ Manual and must sign the passenger indemnity form at the start line.

The minimum age of any passenger is 12 years. Passengers under the age of 16 must have a completed "Clubsport Event Under Age Indemnity and Consent Form" (MSNZ form CS010) or a MSNZ competition license stamped "Authorised Minor". Form CS010 can be downloaded from the MSNZ website or will be available at the event.

The **MINIMUM** number of entries for this event to run is **15**, if this number has not been received by **Friday 26th April 2019**, Organisers reserve the right to cancel the event.

ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY, OR THE ENTRY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

NORMAL ONLINE ENTRIES CLOSE at 5.30pm on Saturday 27th April 2019.

LATE Entries on the day of the event, close at 9.00am, the late entry fee will be an extra **\$25.00**. These entries will need to be on the current HBCC Clubsport Entry Form.

Directions to the venue leave Waipukurau township SH2 intersection, turn Left onto Ruataniwha St in 270m turn Right onto Wellington Rd in 110m slight Left onto Tavistock Road, in 1.6km slight Left onto Farm Rd, in 4km turn Left to stay on Farm Rd for 13km then Pattison Rd is on you Right at Oueroa.

Scrutineering and Documentation is from 8.45 am until 9.45 am at the venue and is in accordance with the current Motorsport Manual. All cars must be presented at scrutineering in a clean and tidy condition. Vehicles will be scrutineered to Schedule A.

Drivers Briefing will be at approx. 10.00 am. This is compulsory for all drivers. One practice run will commence immediately after drivers briefing. The event proper will start immediately after practice; consisting of three official runs, time allowing more unofficial runs may be held.

Unofficial Practice or Reece on the venue prior to the event is PROHIBITED, the residents have been instructed to inform the event Organiser and provide a description of the vehicle. If you are found to be doing this, your entry will NOT be accepted. The HBCC Committee is treating this unacceptable behaviour seriously and you may find you are also excluded from other events.

- 1 point 21st to 25th overall
