- The Permit is for a ClubSport Advanced Bent Sprint.
- Licence Requirements:** All drivers shall hold an M Grade or higher Motorsport NZ issued Competition License. If the Entrant is other than the driver, an Entrants License in the name of the Entrant is required. In addition, all drivers shall hold a valid civil driver's license, and Club Membership of a Motorsport NZ affiliated Club.
- The **MINIMUM** number of entries for this event to run is **15**, if this number has not been received by Thursday 20th June 2019, **organisers reserve the right to cancel the event.**
- Entries should be made through the MotorSport Online system (<https://online.motorsport.org.nz>). Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received. Alternatively, entries may be submitted manually in 'hard copy' form. All such entries must be made on the correct form, must be complete in all detail, and accompanied by the appropriate fees.

NORMAL ONLINE ENTRIES CLOSE at 5.30pm on Friday 21st June 2019.

LATE Entries on the day of the event, close at 9.45am, the late entry fee will be an extra \$25.00. These entries will need to be on the current HBCC Clubsport Entry Form.

5. Scrutineering and Documentation is from 8.45 am until 9.45 am at the venue and is in accordance with the current Motorsport Manual. All cars must be presented at scrutineering in a clean and tidy condition. Vehicles will be scrutineered to Schedule A.

All competitors and passengers shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A. Please be aware of the new requirements that came into effect on the 1st April 2018.

6. Classes:

7. Drivers Briefing will be at approx. 10.00am. This is compulsory for all drivers. One practice run will commence immediately after drivers briefing. The event proper will start immediately after practice; consisting of three official runs.
8. Passengers may be carried in vehicles complying with Appendix 5, Schedule C, Part 1, of the current MSNZ Manual and must sign the passenger indemnity form at the caravan. The minimum age of any passenger is 12 years. Passengers under the age of 16 must have a completed “ClubSport Event Under Age Indemnity and Consent Form” (MSNZ form CS010) or a MSNZ competition licence stamped “Authorised Minor”. Form CS010 can be downloaded from the MSNZ website or will be available at the event.
9. Directions to the venue: Follow Omahu Rd towards Fernhill follow the signs to Taihape, travel up the Taihape until you find Glenross Rd on the left. It is approx. 49km from Stortford Lodge Hastings.
10. Club Points - Hawkes Bay Car Club members are eligible for points for each event towards the club championship. These will be allocated in your HBCC Classes.
11. Unofficial Practice or Reece on the venue prior to the event is PROHIBITED, the residents have been instructed to inform the event Organiser and provide a description of the vehicle. If you are found to be doing this, your entry will NOT be accepted. The HBCC Committee is treating this unacceptable behaviour seriously and you may find you are also excluded from other events.
12. No alcohol is to be consumed by competitors or their crew as this will result in immediate expulsion from the event.
13. Prize giving will be at the HBCC Clubrooms, 1558 Maraekakaho Rd Bridge Pa, we will be advertising this to all club members also as a social evening – BBQ food and drinks will be available for purchase (more details to follow).
