Supplementary Regulations

This event will be held under the provisions of the National Sporting Code of Motorsport New Zealand and any relevant regulations prescriptions or specifications relating thereto as contained in the current NZ Motorsport Manual and amendments, HBCC Speed Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations.

1. The Permit is for a ClubSport Advanced Bent Sprint.
2. Licence Requirements: All drivers shall hold an M Grade or higher Motorsport NZ issued Competition Licence. If the Entrant is other than the driver, an Entrants Licence in the name of the Entrant is required. In addition, all drivers shall hold a valid civil driver's licence, and Club Membership of a Motorsport NZ affiliated Club.
3. All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A. Please be aware of the new requirements that came into effect on the 1st April 2018.
4. Passengers may be carried in vehicles complying with Appendix 5, Schedule C, Part 1, of the current MSNZ Manual and must sign the passenger indemnity form at the start line.
5. The minimum age of any passenger is 12 years. Passengers under the age of 16 must have a completed "Clubsport Event Under Age Indemnity and Consent Form" (MSNZ form CS010) or a MSNZ competition licence stamped "Authorised Minor". Form CS010 can be downloaded from the MSNZ website or will be available at the event.
6. The MINIMUM number of entries for this event to run is 15, if this number has not been received by the Thursday 19th September 2019, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event.

ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY, OR THE ENTRY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

"Normal entry fee" is listed above however there is a discounted fee structure for those who enter both Te Onepu and Moteo Pa Roads (Sun 22 Sept). The fee for entering both events at once will be \$250.

Entries should be made through the MotorSport Online system (<https://online.motorsport.org.nz>). Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received. Alternatively, entries may be submitted manually in 'hard copy' form. All such entries must be made on the correct form, must be complete in all detail, and accompanied by the appropriate fees.

Normal Entries close at 5.30pm on Friday 20th September 2019.

Late Entries will be received up to the day of the event and close at 9.15am. The late entry fee will be **\$175.00**. These entries will need to be on a HBCC ClubSport Entry Form.

7. Scrutineering and Documentation is from 8.45 am until 9.45 am at the venue and is in accordance with the current Motorsport Manual. All cars must be presented at scrutineering in a clean and tidy condition. Vehicles will be scrutineered to Schedule A & AA. To be eligible for Scrutineering to Schedule AA cars must comply with the requirements of Schedules K and T & C. Entries Close at the close of Documentation.

9. Drivers Briefing will be at approx. 10.00am. This is compulsory for all drivers. One practice run will commence immediately after drivers briefing. The event proper will start immediately after practice; and consist of three official runs.
10. Directions to the venue: From Stortford Lodge Sale Yards Hastings, travel South on Maraekakaho Rd, at the roundabout take second exit onto SH50A heading towards Waipukurau/Wellington in 4.0kms at the roundabout take the second exit on SH2 in approx. 20km turn right onto Te Onepu Rd.
11. Club Points - Hawkes Bay Car Club members are eligible for points for each event towards the club championship. These will be allocated in your HBCC Classes.
12. Unofficial Practice or Reece on the venue prior to the event is PROHIBITED, the residents have been instructed to inform the event Organiser and provide a description of the vehicle. If you are found to be doing this, your entry will NOT be accepted. The HBCC Committee is treating this unacceptable behaviour seriously and you may find you are also excluded from other events.
13. No alcohol is to be consumed by competitors or their crew as this will result in immediate expulsion from the event.
14. Prize giving will be at the HBCC Clubrooms, 1558 Maraekakaho Rd Bridge Pa, we will be advertising this to all club members also as a social evening – BBQ food and drinks will be available for purchase (more details to follow).
