- The Permit is for a Clubsport Advanced Hillclimb.
- License Requirements: All drivers shall hold an M Grade or higher Motorsport NZ issued Competition License. If the Entrant is other than the driver, an Entrants License in the name of the Entrant is required. In addition, all drivers shall hold a valid civil driver's license, and Club Membership of a Motorsport NZ affiliated Club.
- Entries must be made through the MotorSport Online system (<https://online.motorsport.org.nz>). Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received.

Entry Fee: \$ 150.00

NORMAL ONLINE ENTRIES CLOSE at 5.30pm on Thursday 1st October.

LATE Entries on the day of the event, close at 9.45am the late entry fee will be an extra \$25.00 These entries will need to be on the current HBCC Clubsport Entry Form.

5. Maximum number of entries is 30. Priority will be given to Registered MSNZ Gold Star Championship competitors.

Organisers reserve the right to refuse any entry in accordance with the prescribed provisions of the National Sporting Code.

6. Scrutineering and Documentation is from 8.45 am until 9.45 am at the venue and is in accordance with the current Motorsport Manual. All cars must be presented at scrutineering in a clean and tidy condition. Vehicles will be scrutineered to Schedule A. Cross Cars must also comply with Schedule XC.

All competitors and passengers shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A.

7. Classes: Vehicles will be divided into the following classes:

Class 1	0 – 1800 cc 2WD
Class 2	1801 cc and over 2WD
Class 3	pre 1996 4WD
Class 4	1996 and newer 4WD
Class 5	Cross Cars

Roll Protection: A Full “Safety Cage”, as defined in Schedule A, is compulsory for this event

Note: HBCC Members Club the results will be converted into club classes for the Club Championship points after the event.

8. Drivers Briefing will be at 10.00 am. This is compulsory for all drivers. The Briefing will be held at the HB Car Club Caravan.
9. There will be a convoy run immediately following the briefing. In accordance with the MSNZ Hillclimb Championship Article 10.4 there will be one timed practice run then three official timed runs.
10. Unofficial Practice or Reece on the venue prior to the event is PROHIBITED, the residents have been instructed to inform the event Organiser and provide a description of the vehicle. If you are found to be doing this, your entry will NOT be accepted.
11. Results will be available after each run as soon as possible and final results posted at Car Club Caravan or alternative notice board to be advised at Drivers Briefing following the last official run.
12. NZ GOLD STAR HILLCLIMB CHAMPIONSHIP AND CHALLENGES:

To be eligible for points competitors must comply with the requirements from 2020/2021 MSNZ Hillclimb Championship articles. Please be familiar with this document.

A Completed Registration Form MUST be received by the Championship Coordinator or their representative before the close of documentation – Article 5.1

13. GENERAL:

DIRECTIONS to the venue: Travel north on SH2 towards Tutira, Waikoau Rd is on the left at the northern end of Lake Tutira.

SERVICE AREA: 6km down Waikoau Rd from SH2 past the finish line just before Mokamoka Rd.

PRIZEGIVING: location will be advised at drivers briefing.

At the prizegiving the Clubsport Commission representative will do a prize draw from the Championship Registered competitors there will be five (5) draws for \$100 cash each. The Competitor must be present to receive this, if they are not then there will be a re draw. Any Competitors who receives a cash prize on the first day of the weekend will not be included in the draw on the second day.

PASSENGERS - may be carried at the discretion of the Clerk of Course in accordance with Appendix 5, Schedule C, Part One, Article 6.
