Supplementary Regulations

This event will be held under the provisions of the National Sporting Code of Motorsport New Zealand and any relevant regulations prescriptions or specifications relating thereto as contained in the current NZ Motorsport Manual and amendments, HBCC Speed Regulations and these Supplementary Regulations.

The Permit is for a ClubSport Advanced Bent Sprint.

Licence Requirements: All drivers shall hold an M Grade or higher Motorsport NZ issued Competition License. If the Entrant is other than the driver, an Entrants License in the name of the Entrant is required. In addition, all drivers shall hold a valid civil drivers license, and Club Membership of a Motorsport NZ affiliated Club.

All competitors shall wear safety apparel in compliance with Appendix Two, Schedule A. Please be aware of the new requirements that came into effect on the 1st April 2018.

Passengers may be carried in vehicles complying with Appendix 5, Schedule C, Part 1, of the current MSNZ Manual and must sign the passenger indemnity form at the start line.

The minimum age of any passenger is 12 years. Passengers under the age of 16 must have a completed “ClubSport Event Under Age Indemnity and Consent Form” (MSNZ form CSport002). This form can be downloaded from the MSNZ website or will be available at the event.

The **MINIMUM** number of entries for this event to run is **15**, if this number has not been received by the **Thursday 13th August 2020**, the organisers reserve the right to cancel the event.

ENTRY FEES MUST ACCOMPANY ENTRY, OR THE ENTRY WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.

Entries should be made through the MotorSport Online system (<https://online.motorsport.org.nz>). Any entry will not be deemed valid until payment is received – all online payments must be paid by Friday 30 April. Alternatively, entries may be submitted manually in ‘hard copy’ form. All such entries must be made on the correct form, must be complete in all detail, and accompanied by the appropriate fees.

Normal Entries close at 5.30pm on Friday 30th April 2021.

Late Entries will be received up to the day of the event and close at 9.15am. The late entry fee will be \$175.00. These entries will need to be on a HBCC Clubsport Entry Form.

Directions to the venue: Mokamoka Rd, Tutira via SH2 north of Napier, 40km north of Bay View turn left on to Waikoau Road, 8km turn right onto Mokamoka Road. Race start is at 1km.

Scrutineering and Documentation is from 8.45 am until 9.45 am at the venue and is in accordance with the current Motorsport Manual. All cars must be presented at scrutineering in a clean and tidy condition. Vehicles will be scrutineered to Schedule A.

Drivers Briefing will be at approx. 10.00 am. This is compulsory for all drivers. One practice run will commence immediately after drivers briefing. The event proper will start immediately after practice; consisting of three official runs, time allowing more unofficial runs may be held.

Unofficial Practice or Reece on the venue prior to the event is PROHIBITED, the residents have been instructed to inform the event Organiser and provide a description of the vehicle. If you are found to be doing this, your entry will NOT be accepted. The HBCC Committee is treating this unacceptable behaviour seriously and you may find you are also excluded from other events.

SERIES POINTS: for each class, based on overall class placing in each Round, will be allocated to each driver as outlined below:

1 point to all other drivers who start in each class.

In addition, bonus points will be added to points gained overall based on the driver's overall position in final results of each round as follows:

- 5 points 1st to 5th overall
- 4 points 6th to 10th overall
- 3 points 11th to 15th overall
- 2 points 16th to 20th overall
- 1 point 21st to 25th overall

No alcohol is to be consumed by competitors or their crew as this will result in immediate expulsion from the event. Prize giving will be held at the Bay View Hotel.
